ICPALD reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids in whole or in part without the obligation to assign any reason for that decision.

INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS

- 1. This invitation for bids is open to all bidders.
- 2. The bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its bid, and ICPALD, shall in no case be responsible or liable for those costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the disposal process.
- 3. The bidder is expected to examine all instructions, forms and terms in the bid documents and complete the forms as required i.e., price schedule, bid form and the confidential

business questionnaire. Failure to meet all the requirements of the bid will be at the bidder's risk and may result in bid rejection.

- 4. A prospective bidder requiring any clarification of the bid document may notify ICPALD by writing an email to elvis.mutii@igad.int and copy to icpald@igad.int with the subject as "Clarifications Bid for Disposal of Motor Vehicles". All clarifications/questions should have been sent to this email address by 4.00pm 21st February 2024.
- 5. ICPALD will respond in writing to bidders by 4.00 PM, 23rd February 2024 on any clarifications that will have been sought.
- 6. The bidder shall indicate on the attached price schedule the unit prices for each of the interested items.
- 7. Prices quoted by the bidder shall be fixed during the bid validity period and not subject to variation on any account. A bid submitted with an adjustable price quotation will be treated as non-responsive and will be rejected.
- 8. The price quoted shall be in Kenya Shillings (KES)
- 9. Bids shall remain valid for 60 days
- 10. Viewing of the bid items will be ongoing until 23rd February 2024 between10.00AM to 4.00PM at ICPALD Offices.
- 11. Prospective bidders are encouraged to view the items at ICPALD Offices before they bid for each item. This will enable them to arrive at the most competitive bids. Bids are based on "AS IS WHERE IS CONDITION" and the conditions of the items are not warranted by the seller.
- 12. Any effort by the Bidder to influence the process will lead to automatic disqualification.
- 13. ICPALD will award the contract to the successful bidder(s) whose bid has been determined to be substantially responsive subject to the reserve prices for each item and discretion of ICPALD

management.

- 14. ICPALD will notify the successful bidder in writing and the successful bidder will be required to make payment within seven days (7 days) of notification of award.
- 15. In the event the successful bidder fails to pay for the item(s) awarded, ICPALD shall notify, the person who had submitted the second highest bid who will be expected to make payment within seven days (7 days).

- 16. Where the item's duties and applicable taxes are not paid, the bidder(s) is/ are responsible to make the necessary payment to the tax authorities after payment of the bid price to ICPALD. In this regard, prospective bidders should verify the duty and taxes status for the items on offer.
- 17. Once the payment is received by ICPALD, the bidder will be expected to sign a sale agreement and undertake to collect the offered items immediately.
